Approval of minutes	Minich	Young	Minutes from the 10/16/23 meeting were approved. The agenda was approved.
District Enrollment and Projections			Glasbrenner shared information on our current student numbers. He also shared projections of FTE for the 24-25 school year. A special focus was placed on numbers between 4K and 5K, as well as the number of students that enter the RVSD in 5th grade due to St. John's changing their grade configurations. Glasbrenner shared FTE conversations that will be taking place in January, which include projected class sizes.
Calendar Survey results			Glasbrenner shared the survey results and the expectations of staff during snow days/virtual learning days, which reflect either vacation or virtual instruction.
Academic and Career Planning summary	Iausly	Cates	Glasbrenner shared that he met with school counselors to discuss ACP (Academic and Career Planning). HS counselors started and then middle school and elementary counselors walked through a new sheet that aligns RVSD High School Portrait of a Graduate (which starts with the Responsive Classroom curriculum at RVE and connects to the Blackhawk Code lessons that happen in grades K-8.) The document was forwarded to the full board for approval.
Review of District Goals			As we are at mid-year, Glasbrenner shared progress on district goals. Both academic and Social Emotional Learning/climate teams at each building have made progress and continue to work on building goals that directly relate to district goals.
