Approval of minutes	Iausly	Young	Minutes from the previous meeting were approved; agenda was approved.
Professional Development 2023-2024 timeline			Glasbrenner shared the drafted professional development calendar for all staff. He noted that the half days utilized last year have transitioned to full days in this school calendar. Assessment Literacy will be a focus (summative, formative, observational, benchmark, screening, etc). The committee spent time discussing the February all staff inservice. A focus on student wellness (physical/emotional) and staff (physical/emotional) will be considered. Young shared that this opportunity has the potential to be incredibly helpful. Choices for staff will be necessary as it needs to meet a variety of needs. Iausly asked about Quartz Insurance and any programs offered. Radtke agreed. Peterson suggested that Trauma Informed practices for staff continues to be needed.
C&I Renewal and Design			Glasbrenner shared that Business Education, Social Studies, and PE/Health will be focus areas for the 2023-2024 school year.
Gifted and Talented Handbook			Glasbrenner walked through the pages in the drafted handbook and allowed committee members to ask questions. Radtke shared that the guidelines have been very helpful as students and parents have questions about programming and placement. Radtke also shared that these services have advanced to structures for students rather than after school enrichment activities.

Peterson shared goals for the River Valley Early Learning Center which include teacher training in literacy practices, Radtke shared goals for the River Valley Middle School which include assessment practices, and River Valley High School goals were shared which focus on small group instructional practices and co-teaching methods.
